PLEASE READ BELOW VERY CAREFULLY!!

As per our previous tournaments, the SSKA uses a web-based registration system.

Go to www.kihapp.com and then select Tournaments at the top, scroll down to the SSKA Nationals, click on the link and you will be presented with a simple interface to register your Association, Schools, Referees, Coaches and Students.

Once a student has been registered, the categories they can compete in will be automatically shown.

If your student wishes to move up a category*, in line with our Chief Referee's amendments, you can use the 'Fight-up' section on each competitors registration page.

It is highly recommended that registrations are completed carefully by a single representative of your dojo or Association.

BACS details are in this pack and online, along with a full list of categories. You may still use the manual forms supplied, but please be mindful of the final entry date when posting.

*You are reminded that all students aged 35 years and below may not move up to the Veterans categories, but the Veterans may compete ONE category below their own.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING CAR PARKING AT THE EVENT

The Orford Hub maintains a very strict parking policy. You may park anywhere on the event site and parking is **FREE** for up to 3 hours. Please Note: Due to the varied nature of the styles, all attending clubs are requested to supply their own referees and table officials to assist with the judging of the events.

It is the competitors choice whether the Pairs/Team Kata begins in-line or on-line, but must be facing the Head Judge.

All judges are expected to adhere to the ethos of the Karate code of conduct of impartiality when adopting this role. **Food and refreshments will be provided for registered officials.**

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

All categories shall be run to completion; there shall be no separate finals. Trophies and medals shall be awarded on each mat area. **All categories shall be judged on points, as per WUKF rules.**

The number of rounds per category will be determined by the Chief Referee once all entries have been submitted and compiled.

18-35 years competitors are NOT permitted to enter the 36 plus years categories. Veterans are permitted to move down ONE category. All other competitors may move up ONE AGE category (including pairs and teams).

Tie breaks in the final shall be decided by Flags when applicable.

Minimum amount of entries is 5 per event, 4 entries and less = event cancelled. In principle, the competitor will be moved up into the next age category. Under 15's brackets may be merged as Boys/Girls to create a category. In the event of a category being cancelled, the club instructor will be notified by email. **The club instructor is responsible for informing the competitor.**

All categories shall have the draw sorted by a specifically designed random selection system.

All coaches **must** wear full official tracksuits/uniforms.

All coaches wishing to address the top table **must** display a valid coach's badge and be dressed in full coach's attire.

Contestants deemed to be inappropriately dressed shall be allowed a limited period to rectify matters after which time, if they have not conformed to the requirements, they will be disqualified.

It is accepted that all club officials will impress on their students that the mat areas are for the actual competitors only.

It is also expected that all the competitors shall show respect for their compatriots, the officials, the spectators and the event staff.
